



## RESOLUTION TO JOIN THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, certain areas of Essex Junction are subject to periodic flooding and flooding-caused erosion that may cause serious damages to structures within these areas; and,

WHEREAS, flood insurance is available to owners of structures throughout the community through the National Flood Insurance Program as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and,

WHEREAS, through participation in the National Flood Insurance Program this community may qualify for grant funds to mitigate existing risks to public investments, and qualify for disaster aid; and,

WHEREAS, this community is committed to acting as enabled under state statutes 10 VSA Chapter 32 and to adopt appropriate land use regulations under 24 VSA Chapter 117 to protect public health, safety and welfare; and,


WHEREAS, this community is committed to not increasing the risk to residents, structures, and public investments already in high risk areas; and






