1. Call to Order

Micah called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Minutes Review

MOTION by Cathy, SECOND by Phoebe to APPROVE the May meeting minutes. ALL IN FAVOR.

3. Discussion re. Various

In follow up to prior meeting. Jeff informed UVM that no additional effort was needed on their part in terms of the Capstone Design projects. A Village DropBox folder has been set up and Raj will be putting in the reports. Once that is done, the Committee can summarize the key take aways/recommendations for the Trustees.

4. Discussion re. Results of Community Ride

Cathy and Jeff rode around the Village on Sunday, June 9th. A summary document has been put in the BWAC DropBox folder.

Several crosswalk signs are obscured by trees. Most notably one by ADL and one at the corner of West & West St. Extension.

Crosswalk painting has not yet commenced. There was a good bit of discussion on 3D painting, especially by school and parks. Maple St Park crosswalks were thought to be a good opportunity. Cathy found info from Medford MA on their use and will be contacting them.

5. Discussion re. Bike Rack/Crosswalk Markers Purchasing

Three "bike shaped" bike racks from Dero will be purchased if they can be delivered by the months end. Phoebe was going to look for alternative sources should Dero be unable to deliver. Cathy suggested creating FPF post on ideas on where to install. Committee discussed library, fair grounds, schools, and parks as possibilities.

The repair stand considered for Maple St. Park is not needed as a system has already been purchased and is awaiting install.

The Committee discussed purchasing mid-street crosswalk markers. Micah indicated Public Works has several in storage. The Committee will work with the Village (via Darby) to see about getting some installed.

The Committee discussed purchasing helmets but learned 30 had just been given away at the CHIPS bike swap.

6. Discussion re. Rapid Reflective Beacon Plan

The Committee is tasked on developing a comprehensive plan on where flashing crosswalk beacons should be placed. It was unclear to the current Committee members what beacons were already installed or were in the process of being installed. This information will be requested from the Village (via Darby) and be put on a map for reference.

7. Various

There are several trails in the Village that are accessible to the public. The Committee discussed purchasing vertical trail markers from next year's budget that can be placed at their entrance points.

Priorities for the coming year were discussed. (1) Siting crosswalk beacons, (2) Bike rack placements, (3) Public trail marking, (4) Bike safety event, (5) Other outreach, (6) Walk friendly neighborhood application.

Micah discussed conversations with a potential new Committee member.

There was no community input.
