- Park Street Fatality Intersection of Park Street and Franklin Street. An idea popped up for the possibility of having bike lights to give out in the Village. If too expensive, can ask local bike shops for recommendations for bike lights and let residents know. Stickers as reflectors might also (or instead of lights) can be obtained and given out to be placed on bikes and helmets. Working with schools for informational handouts or workshops on these types of things. Helmet lights? Crossing guards with stash of these reflector stickers could potentially hand out to people that are biking at crossings. If posters will be made for students related to bike safety, a possible collaboration with school and/or crossing guards can occur. Ramon read an article describing colors worn when biking as being safer and will share with Carolyn.
- **Final RRFB Grant Application** The application was sent out and in process. If/when the grant is awarded the funds would come around June and the BWAC may have to work quickly to place orders in order to use the funding.
