1. Agenda Additions or Changes – nothing added or changed to the agenda.

- 2. **Review August 23rd Minutes** Evan made a motion to approve the 8/23 minutes. Eric seconded. The motion passed 4-0.
- 3. Out and About in Essex This topic was on hold until Annie arrived. Annie spoke about the path and map that BWAC agreed to create. Micah spoke about how to utilize the path and give trail markers. Evan agreed with the course of action. Evan and Micah were thinking 12 cones are going to be needed for O&A to outline the path. Linda offered the idea she and Owiso spoke about of having a temporary spray paint and making an O&A with arrows. Linda can design and print onto large paper. A volunteer may be needed to cut out of cardboard and have ready for BWAC. Annie can purchase the spray paint and is asking BWAC to paint on the morning of. Evan asked about the tent and a table to talk about BWAC. Evan made the map and there was discussion to laminate it and present it.  - Micah spoke about traffic calming studies as well as the BWAC policies in the Village. Less stringent requirements are being considered than what is in the policy. Nick Meyer offered that tree planting has helped to slow down traffic in areas.

- 6. **Crosswalk flags/Pedestrian crossing signs** Micah offered the idea for budget season to add some number of these to purchase and keep at the Village Public Works as the ones that we have are old and needing replacement.
