1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Andrew Brown called the meeting to order at 6 PM.

2. AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

None.

4. FINALIZE CAPITAL BUDGET

There was discussion of the existing capital reserve plan provided by the Finance Director. Rick Jones mentioned the broken water valve on Lamoille Street that created a dead-end line which needs to be addressed. The committee felt the water line situation would change the cost of deferral for the project so the Lamoille Street project should be re-ranked.

Re-Ranking of Lamoille Street Project - Q: 52

The new ranking of Lamoille Street (Q) puts the project ahead of the Pearl Street project (UU). Finance Director, Lauren Morrisseau, will be asked to change the capital reserve plan to reflect the new ranking.

Tim Dall observed Rick Jones identified four projects to be done that differ from the list of prioritized projects by the Capital Review Committee, noting remaining service life was likely considered a factor. Following discussion the committee agreed to add "Remaining Life" as a ranking criterion. The definition of "Remaining Life" is as follows:

- Assessment of project condition based upon input from village staff and consultants.
- Assessment ratings are:
 - \circ Urgent = 24
 - \circ 1-5 years = 18
 - \circ 5-10 years = 12
 - \circ 10-15 years = 6

The committee will review the definition at the next meeting and rank projects with the new criterion included.

5. APPROVE MINUTES
