Bill Date - This is the date the bill was produced.

Fixed Rate Period - The fixed fees on each bill cover a four month period.

Direct Debit - If your account is set up to be paid automatically you will see this reminder to not send payment.

Due Date-The due date is the last day to pay before incurring penalty. Payment must be received by this date; postmarks will not be accepted.

> Stub-Please return the bottom section of the bill with payment. The barcode on the stub helps ensure payment is applied to the correct account.

Meter Reading Info - Consumption is listed in hundreds of cubic feet; the meter factor converts the consumption figure into gallons.

Amount - There are two types of charges on a City utility bill; Fixed Charges and Usage (Variable) Charges.

The Fixed Charges are based on the number of units assigned to your property. All single family residential properties are assigned 1.00 unit. For rental, industrial, multi-family, or commercial properties the number of units is recalculated annually in June. 1.00 unit represents 120 gallons per day of usage. For example, if the prior year usage averaged 240 gallons per day you would be assigned 2.00 units.

Usage (Variable) Charges are based on metered consumption between the two reading dates.
