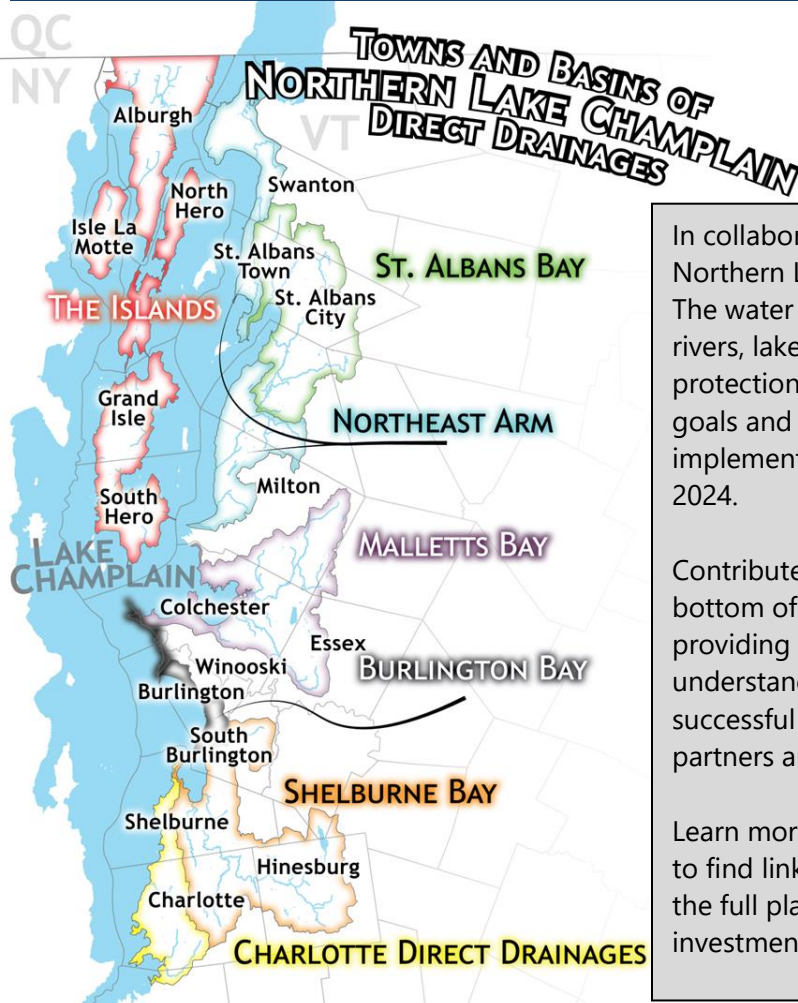

In collaboration with partners, Vermont is updating the Northern Lake Champlain Direct Drainages Tactical Basin Plan. The water quality and habitat management plan identifies rivers, lakes and wetlands in need of restoration and protection. It also outlines actions to achieve water quality goals and identifies partners and funding critical to implementing the actions. The plan will be released end of 2024.
