Sealed Bids for the construction of the Proposed Densmore Drive Upstream Culvert Replacement will ONLY be received and accepted via online electronic bid service through <https://www.questcdn.com> until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **Friday, November 19, 2021** at such time will be opened publicly online. The 5-day lead time is required in case the bid opening time changes.

The Project consists of replacing two deteriorated 6-ft diameter (70-ft long) CMP culverts with a 20-ft span precast concrete box culvert, including 230-ft of roadway reconstruction. The engineer's estimate for the work is between \$600,000 and \$700,000. The anticipated project schedule is to start construction about June 2022 and complete construction about September 2022, with tree clearing activities between January 2022 and March 2022.
