1. Call to Order

Nick called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

2. Minutes Approval

3. 2019 Planting

Darby said that there had been no affirmative responses to the planting letter sent out a few weeks ago. 4. Arbor Day Conference

As a Tree City, the Village receives two tickets to the Vermont Arbor Day Conference. Warren and Mary Jo will be using these tickets to attend. Warren noted that the Urban & Community Forestry Program has extra "Tree City USA" signs available.

5. Arbor Day Celebration

This year's Arbor Day Celebration will be held at Hiawatha School. Additional details will be available closer to the event.

6. Budget Update

Darby informed the committee that planting funds are now separated from removal funds. She will work with Public Works to divide this year's purchases into their new line items.

7. Branch Out Burlington

The committee discussed the Tree Keeper workshop that they are planning with Branch Out Burlington (BOB). This will be held on April 4th, from 6-8 PM. Darby will create a Facebook event and take care of event publicity.

There will be a nursery clean up and planting day at the BOB nursery on May 4th. More details will be provided closer to the event. The committee discussed inviting the Essex Reporter. This may also be a good time to formally issue a press release about the committee's partnership with BOB (growing trees in the BOB nursery). It is hoped that this event will attract new volunteers who may be interested in consistently being involved with the committee's work.
